Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the text 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. Class 3 will be writing their own book review at the end of this unit to recommend it to other children around the school and writing a leaflet based on the book.

Maths

In Maths Class 3 will be learning how to compare, order, add and subtract fractions. We will also learn how to find fractions of amounts. In addition to this we will be using formal methods for addition and subtraction.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is living things and their habitats. We will be identifying different habitats around the world and investigating how living things adapt to their environment.

Computing

We will continue learning how to print, save and retrieve our work. Alongside this we will use the program scratch to dress up a sprite using coding.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Angels'.

Physical Education

PE for Class 3 will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. We will be having Aspire on Mondays and gymnastics on Tuesdays. Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school every day as we may have opportunities for outside learning on other days of the week.

Music

In music we will be continuing to use recorders to learn simple tunes and read simple music.

PSE - Personal and Social Education

This half term we will be learning how to deal with falling out with friends and getting on with others.

French

In French we will be learning how to say numbers and apply this by understanding people giving their age and being able to respond by saying our own age.

Geography

We will be learning about the deserts around the world looking at maps and atlases. We will also compare their climate to ours and investigate biomes. Alongside our science learning we will look at the animals that live there and how they adapt to the environment.

DT

In DT this half term, we will be creating a desert scene using a range of textile materials. We will design, make and evaluate using the skill of sewing.
