

Class 2 - I'll Huff and I'll Puff!

What are we going to be learning in Class Two?

In literacy we will be reading Pie Corbett's version of 'The Three Little Pigs' and an alternative version of the tale- 'The True Story of The Three Little Pigs.' In maths we will be learning about multiplication and division, identifying 2-D shapes and learn to add and subtract two digit numbers using a number line. In science, we will continue investigating the different uses of materials and their properties with a link to the literacy texts. We will spend a week this half term focusing on the significance of Remembrance Day and the meaning of the poppy symbol. This will involve some history, literacy and art work. In DT the children will be learning about levers and sliders in the context of moving picture books. In our music lessons we will be working on voice and body percussion. P.E will be on a Tuesday when the children will be continuing to improve their ball skills and on a Thursday when we will be doing gymnastics. Our R.E concept this half term is 'Celebration' in the context of Jesus's birthday.

How can learning be extended at home?

Please support your child at home with daily reading, homework, spellings and maths challenge cards. Spelling test day will continue to be on a Thursday and five new spellings will be taken home the following day. Homework will be set on a Friday and should be handed in by the following Wednesday please.
