This week, we will be focussing on writing a resumé and a book review in Literacy. First task, new vocabulary, look up and learn what a resumé is! (Can you guess which language it comes from?) Sadly, it is our last week of work on the book 'Wonder.' Be honest in your book review. We say so often in Class that anyone can have their own opinion and it must be respected if it based on a well-reasoned view. Give evidence from the text and support your view with reasons.

In Maths, we focus on fractions. We have received feedback that some children in the school are finding the Whiterose Maths challenging. If you are, please know that you can take longer over each task, meaning it is OK to only do a few of the tasks, if you are completing Maths learning each day. Friday's Maths has the option of doing some cooking. If you think you might want to do this, do have a look, and make sure you have your ingredients ready.

Your extra task 1 is French. You will be revising the words for some animals alongside learning new ones. There are many websites which will translate between the two languages. On these sites, you will find a symbol so that you can hear the correct pronunciation of the words in French; I encourage you to use these, to ensure you are saying the words in French correctly. Remember to have fun, say the words around the house and garden in lots of different voices!

Extra task 2 is RE. On Thursday May 21st it is Ascension Day, an important day for Christians around the world. You will be learning why.

Extra task 3 is Geography and you will be building on the learning about volcanoes and earthquakes we did last year, by applying it in the context of the state of California.
