‘Survival of the fittest’

Literacy

The Literacy for this half term will be based on the book 'The Fastest Boy in the World' by Elizabeth Laird. The children will write in a range of genre and forms including biographies, diaries and news reports. We will continue to work on our key grammar, spelling and punctuation targets.

Maths

Year 6 will be bringing home Maths revision cards to help consolidate their learning; please go through the cards with them regularly. Both year groups will begin the year with a unit of work on co-ordinates, followed by key number work on the four operations and fractions.

Science

In Science we will be learning the main parts of the human circulatory system and will be considering the impact of diet, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function.

Computing and E-safety

Our computing will include writing an algorithm, a program, for a journey across a map of the world, from the UK to Ethiopia, whilst our E-safety will revisit our ways to safe on social media and the internet.

Religious Education

Years 5 and 6 will consider 'Jesus through Art' within the concept of 'Imagery.' We will consider how imagery is used to express ideas and beliefs.

Physical Education

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays, this half term on the outdoor elements such as orienteering, whilst Tuesday's focus is gymnastics. Remember that children can wear plimsolls for gymnastics, but not trainers.

PSE – Personal and Social Education

Our key focus will be 'Going for goals,' followed by a shorter unit on how we each play a role in society including how all jobs are important to a society working well.

French

In French, we will be revising the days of the week and months of the year, followed by new learning on the seasons. We will continue to extend our conversational vocabulary within the context of birthdays.

Geography

We will be learning about biomes. These are specific environments in which specific types of animals and plants are found. We will be learning what lives where and in what conditions!

Design Technology.

In DT we will be learning how different shaped cams affect the movement of a riser.

Music

We will again be taking part in the combined Schools Junior Choir this year. There will be lessons learning the songs within school and rehearsals with other schools before the performances on Monday 16th March and Wednesday 18th March at the Festival Hall in Petersfield, in the evening.
