Thank you in advance for your support and cooperation with this.

Emmie and Arthur deserve a special mention for the amazing 6 O'Clock News video they sent from the historic VE Day in 1945. It put a smile on all our faces!


I hope you all have a fantastic weekend - it looks like the weather will once again be kind to us.
