Maths

 - Times Tables Rock Stars
 - BBC Bitesize 'Guardians: Defenders of Mathematica'
 - Mathsframe - Maths Games

Writing

- to continue to learn spellings from the 'Spelling Cards' (on the School website). Spelling Cards 5, 6 and 7 are aimed at Years 3 and 4. The expectation is that children can spell all these words by the end of Year 4. Maybe select 5 spellings per week to focus on and by the end of the holidays that will be 30 new words!
- to write / draw / create a diary about their Summer holidays. This could be written every day, a few times a week or when something significant has happened. A prize will be given to the best one when we come back to school in September.
